Ride times will be posted on the show website by Wednesday, July 27th.

Stall assignments will be posted on the show website by Wednesday, July 27th. They will also be posted on the Show Grounds by 9:00 AM on Friday, July 29th. Stall bedding (1 or 2 bags of shavings per stall, depending on whether you have paid for Friday-Sunday or only for day stall) will not be distributed until the day listed for arrival on the entry form. The price of **extra bedding** is: **\$8.00** per bag of shavings. Please email Dianne Boyd with orders for extra shavings.

Stop by the show office each morning for **hot beverages and bagels** generously sponsored by **Lisa Seger Insurance (Markel)**.

On Saturday evening, don't forget to attend the **Competitor's party** at the show office!! (This is in front of our mobile show office. The show office will be located in the SW corner of Barn F.) We'll have wine, beer, other beverages and hors d'oeuvres. The party is generously sponsored by **Red Letter Farm** and **Karen Brame**. It will start at the end of classes on Saturday.

On Sunday afternoon, an **Ice Cream break**, generously sponsored by Encore Sporthorse Inc., will be held after the lunch break.

The N.C. Dept. of Agriculture requires that a copy of a current **NEGATIVE COGGINS** test be available to the State Veterinarian's office for each horse entering the facility. Exhibitors **MUST** post a copy of the Coggins on the horse's stall door or at your trailer if you are not stabled. Any equine without a negative Coggins test will immediately be quarantined back to its point of origin. **NO** horses (including non-competing horses) will be permitted on the grounds unless they have registered prior to arrival with the secretary and submitted a current negative Coggins test.

For those who are driving and using Mapquest or GPS systems for directions to NC State Fair Hunt Horse Complex, **the physical address is: 4601 Trinity Road, Raleigh, NC.**

Day parking is limited to the north side of Barn F. There are a few trees on the north side that can provide shade for trailers. *Please note that trailers CANNOT be parked on the paved roads around any barns that are occupied by horses. Also, trailers cannot be parked between Barn F and the dressage warmup ring. This area is limited to vendors and car parking.* A hunter/jumper show will be using the rest of the facility over the weekend and will be using two of the barns. **All horses for the Raleigh Summer Dressage shows will be stabled in Barns D and E. Please do not park any cars or trailers around the barns, particularly between Barns C and D!!**

Braiding services will be provided on a first-come basis by **Karen Brame**. Competitors should contact Karen for advance reservations at redletterfarm@aol.com or 336-404-0640. Please leave a message and she will get back to you if you don't reach her in person.

NEW HEADGEAR RULE FOR DRESSAGE

Effective March 1, 2011, for dressage: **Anyone mounted on a horse must wear protective headgear except those riders age 18 and over while on horses that are competing only in FEI levels and tests at the Prix St. Georges level and above.** This includes riders on non-competing horses. Protective headgear is defined as a riding helmet which meets or exceeds ASTM/SEI standards for equestrian use and carries the SEI tag. The headgear and harness must be secured and properly fitted at all times while mounted. Any rider violating this rule at any time will immediately be prohibited from further riding until such headgear is properly in place.
