**Ride times** will be posted on the show website by Wednesday, July 23<sup>rd</sup>. **The show office will be located in the stall office inside gate H-4.**

**Stall assignments** will be posted on the show website by Wednesday, July 23<sup>th</sup>. They will also be posted on the Show Grounds by 9:00 AM on Friday, July 25<sup>th</sup>. Stall bedding (1 or 2 bags of shavings per stall, depending on whether you have paid for Friday-Sunday or only for day stall) will not be distributed until the day listed for arrival on the entry form. The price of **extra bedding** is: **\$8.00** per bag of shavings. Please email Dianne Boyd with orders for extra shavings. **Note that horses should not arrive before noon and check-in starts at noon on Friday!**

The N.C. Dept. of Agriculture requires that a copy of a current **NEGATIVE COGGINS** test be available to the State Veterinarian's office for each horse entering the facility. Exhibitors **MUST** post a copy of the Coggins on the horse's stall door or trailer if you are not stabled. Any equine without a negative Coggins test will immediately be quarantined back to its point of origin. **NO** horses (including non-competing horses) are permitted on the grounds unless they have registered prior to arrival with the secretary and submitted a current negative Coggins.

For those who are driving and using Mapquest or GPS systems for directions to NC State Fair Hunt Horse Complex, **the physical address is: 4601 Trinity Road, Raleigh, NC.**

**Day parking is limited to the north side of Barn F.** There are a few trees on the north side that can provide shade for trailers. *Please note that trailers CANNOT be parked on the paved roads around any barns that are occupied by horses. Also, trailers cannot be parked between Barn F and the dressage warmup ring. This area is limited to vendors and car parking.* There will be no H/J show on the grounds this year but a polo exhibition will be held in the main coliseum on Friday and Saturday nights. **All horses for RSD will be stabled in Barns D and E. Please do not park any cars or trailers around the barns, particularly between Barns C and D!!**

**From the time horses are officially admitted to the competition grounds by competition management, anyone mounted on a horse at any time on the competition grounds, including non-competing riders, riders on non-competing horses, and those competing in all classes and tests, including Para-Equestrian tests, must wear protective headgear.**
