

2017 Raleigh Summer Dressage I.II Awards

- Prize and five ribbons in each Dressage & DSHB class.
- Separate awards for Open, AAs and/or Jr/Yrs in any Dressage Open class with four or more in any division. All divisions (if specifically offered) pinned separately. Exception: Open, GAIG/USDF Qual & CBLM scored & pinned together. Sponsored by M&M Tack Shop.
- Dressage High Score awards at Training-Fourth Levels, FEI Levels combined in each competition (ex. Equitation, Materiale, Freestyle, Opportunity, Rider & YH tests). Sponsored by Foxden Equine and GumBits.
- DSHB Championship classes receive Champion and Reserve Championship ribbons.
- DSHB Grand Champion: Will receive special award and neck sash. Sponsored by Foxden Equine and Rosinburg Events.
- USDFBC: The Champion & Reserve Champion in classes B13, B14, B15, B17 and B18 in each show will receive special ribbons and will qualify for the USDF Breeders Championship East Coast Series Final at Dressage at Devon.
- Trainers Award (Dressage): Trainer plus min. two students. Awarded to team with highest average at each show. Sign-up in office by 10:00 am at first show competing. Additional details posted on sign-up form. Sponsored by Pierre Renard Embroidered Designs and Dressage Today.
- USDF Dover Medal: Awarded to highest scoring eligible AA receiving at least 60% in Cl. #123 & #223.
- M&M Tack Pro Am Team Challenge. One professional plus 2-3 AAs, JRs or Yrs. Awarded on Saturday.
- High Score AA (ea. show): To highest scoring AA in any class ex. Equitation, Materiale, Freestyle, Intro, Rider & YH. Sponsored by Pierre Renard Embroidered Designs and Dressage Today.
- High Score Jr/YR (each show): To highest scoring Jr/YR in any class ex. Equitation, Materiale, Freestyle, Intro, Rider & YH tests. Sponsored by Dressage Today and GumBits.
- "Newcomer" Award (each show): A special award to highest scoring rider competing in his/her first USEF/USDF Dressage Competition. Sponsored by Dressage Today.
- Club High Score (each show): To the highest scoring NCDCTA member in any class except Equitation, Materiale, Freestyle, Intro, Rider & YH tests. Sponsored by Dressage Today and Rosinburg Events.
- Sherry Norris Colson Best Groom Award: Winner receives artwork plus \$100 cash award. Awarded at competitor party. Saturday Ring Stewards choose winner. Sponsored by Jimmy Collins Art and friends.
- Best Seat Award (each show): Judges select best seat in FEI and National level classes. Two separate awards. Sponsored by GumBits, Harbor Sweets and Rosinburg Events.
- Pony Test of Choice: Entries in these classes will be eligible for 2017 National Dressage Pony Cup (NDPC) year-end awards. Sponsored by Stonefield Farm.
- National Dressage Pony Cup Championship and High Point Awards (each show): High Point award to the highest scoring pony in any class except Equitation, Materiale, Freestyle, Intro, Rider & YH tests. NDPC Championship ribbon to be sent from NDPC. Only ponies with valid USEF measurement certificates submitted to the show secretary will be eligible for either award. All eligible for NDPC year-end awards. Sponsored by Stonefield Farm.
- TIP Awards: The Jockey Club Thoroughbred Incentive Program (T.I.P.) is offering a high score and reserve ribbons for Thoroughbreds. Eligible horses must provide T.I.P. Numbers to the event secretary with entry. For more information, visit www.tiptip.com. All classes count except Equitation, Materiale, Freestyle, Intro, Rider & YH tests.
- American Hanoverian Society: Special ribbon to the highest placing eligible Hanoverian in individual in-hand classes (IBC excluded). In order to be eligible, horse must be AHS registered and owner must be a current AHS member. Eligibility with AHS verified week before show. Sponsored by AHS.
- Dressage High Score Hanoverian: Sponsored by AHS. No AHS membership required. All levels eligible, excluding Intro, Equitation, Materiale, Freestyle, Rider & YH tests. Winner receives neck sash. One Dressage award for both shows combined, to be presented at the end of RSD II on Sunday.
- "Born in the USA" Award: One separate Dressage award for each show. One DSHB award for both shows combined. Awarded to highest scoring (not highest placing) horse foaled in U.S. Eligibility determined by breeder's address on horse's registration papers or other verification in writing. Excl. Equitation, Materiale, Freestyle, Intro, Rider & YH tests. DSHB includes indiv. in-hand & IBC, but not handler, group, under saddle or Materiale classes. Sponsored by High Time Photography.
- High Score North Carolina Horse: Awarded to highest scoring (not highest placing) DSHB horse born in NC. Eligibility determined by breeder's address on horse's reg. papers or other verification in writing. Includes indiv. in-hand & IBC, but not handler, group, under saddle or Materiale classes. (One award/both shows combined.) Sponsored by High Time Photography.
- American Saddlebred Horse Association (each show): Sponsored by ASHA; To highest scoring horse enrolled in the American Saddlebred Sport Horse Year End Awards Program and owner must be an ASHA member. Scores count in any class ex. Equitation, Materiale, FS, Intro, Rider & YH tests. Must show proof to show office of eligibility.
- North American Danish Warmblood Assn (Dressage & DSHB) (sponsored by NADWA): To highest scoring NADWA member-owned registered horse in any class ex. Equitation, Materiale, FS, Intro, Rider, YH tests; DSHB incl. indiv. in-hand and IBC, but not handler, group, US or Materiale classes.
- American Trakehner Assn (Dressage & DSHB) (sponsored by ATA): To highest scoring ATA member-owned reg. horse in any class ex. Equitation, Materiale, FS, Intro, Rider, YH tests; DSHB incl. indiv. in-hand and IBC, but not handler, group, US or Materiale classes.
- American Warmblood Society (sponsored by AWS): To highest scoring AWS registered horse in any class ex. Equitation, Materiale, FS, Intro, Rider & YH tests.
- Jovee Farm Performance Pony Awards: RSD I: Prize & ribbon for Champion & Reserve Champion Adult (AA+Open) & Jr/YR in all dressage cl ex. Equitation, Materiale, FS, Rider & YH tests. RSD I & II combined: High-score DSHB pony in hand: Includes indiv. in-hand & IBC, but not handler or group. If age 3 or over must have current USEF Pony Meas. Certif. If under three must present evidence that sire and/or dam (either or both) are reg. with pony breed or have a valid USEF Pony Meas. Certificate.
